GENERAL LICENSE NO. 6

Third-country Diplomatic and Consular Funds Transfers Authorized

U.S. depository institutions, U.S.-registered brokers or dealers in securities, and U.S.-registered money transmitters are authorized to process funds transfers necessary for the operating expenses or other official business of third-country diplomatic or consular missions in North Korea.

Note to General License 6: This general license does not authorize funds transfers involving financial institutions that are blocked pursuant to any part of 31 CFR chapter V other than part 510.
